Whatever we don't turn into praise turns into blame.	
What's our "normal response" to God when life gets overwhelming?	
2. Singing to Goways that nothing else can. (Ephesians 5:18-19a; Psalm 59	
Music is what feelings sound like.	
God has wired our souls to be moved by music!	
Worshiping God can bring comfort in the midst of overwhelm.	
3. Worship God's	
in the midst of spiritual battles. (Acts 16:26)	
Praise opens the door for others to see God. (Acts 16:27-33)	
Praise paves the way to joy for you and others. (Acts 16:34)
