

Soundtrack: The Soundtrack of the Blessed

What does a “blessed” life look like? (Psalm 112:1-9)

1. Blessing is a result of living with the right perspective.

(Psalm 112:1b)

- To “fear the Lord” means He receives from me what is rightfully His.
 - God calls for my undivided attention, my unrivaled awe, and my unparalleled allegiance.
- When I fear God, I can let my other fears go. (Psalm 112:7-8)

Lecrae: “We fear circumstances so much because we fear God so little.”

What fears do I need to let go of, and remember who God is instead?

2. Respond with a loving obedience that will change our world.

(Psalm 112:1, 5-6)

What am I going to be remembered for?

- God wants to leave a legacy through our generosity!

Generosity can be contagious, spontaneous, and fun!

- Our generosity is a reflection and overflow of God’s generosity, which has enduring results. (Psalm 111:3b, 5; Psalm 112:9a)
- The “blessed life” is the life that blesses others. (2 Corinthians 9:8-11)
