## It's Personal: Character

*Competency* determines what I *can* do. *Chemistry* determines *who* I can do it with. *Commitment* determines what I *want* to do. *Character* determines what I will *actually* do.

"Reputation is what people think of us; character is what God knows of us."

How do I develop Christ-like character that impacts my relationships? (1 Samuel 18:1-3 NLT)

1. <u>Show</u> the kind of <u>love</u> to others that I want shown to me. (1 Samuel 18:3 NLT)

When you think of something good to say, *say it*. When you think of something special to do, *do it*. When you want something different, *be it*.

What kind of character does God want to develop in me? (Galatians 5:22-23a NLT)

- 2. <u>Build</u> the <u>foundations</u> of my relationships when no one is looking. (1 Samuel 19:1-5 NLT)
- Godly character is faithful to God's Word.
- Godly character honors God in all positions.
- Godly character remains vulnerable. (Psalm 19:12)
- Godly character remains repentant. (Psalm 51)
- **3.** <u>Stay loyal</u> through the highs and the lows. (1 Samuel 20:1-4 NLT; Proverbs 17:17 NLT)
