(1 Samuel 18:3 NIV)

When you want something different, **be it.**

What kind of character does God want to develop in me?

(Galatians 5:22-23 NLT)

2. Build the foundations of my relationships when no one is looking.

(1 Samuel 19:1-5 NIV)

- Godly character **remains in God's Word.**
- Godly character **honors God in all positions.**
- Godly character **remains vulnerable.**
- Godly character **practices repentance.**

3. Stay loyal through the highs and the lows. (1 Samuel 20:1-4 NIV)
