

Flash Theology: God is Wise

Why should I **trust** God? (Job 38:1-11 NLT)

1. **God is eternally wise**. (Job 38:2 NLT; Romans 16:27 NIV; Psalm 147:5 NET)

FLASH FACT: *Omnisapient* = “all wise”

- a. God’s **wisdom** is beautifully **complex**. (Job 38:4-5 NLT)

We live in a world that is **post-Fall** and **pre-Eschaton**. (Isaiah 55:8-9 NIV)

“If God would concede me his **omnipotence [power]** for twenty-four hours, you would see how many changes I would make in the world. **But if he gave me his wisdom** too, I would leave things as they are.”

2. **God’s wisdom compels me to trust Him**. (Job 42:1-6 NLT)

Job’s resolution was **not** through an **explanation from** God but an **encounter with** God.

Let the **character of God** as seen in the cross be the **wisdom** that shapes my **perspective**.

Bottom Line: God is **worthy** of our trust **because** He is **wise**.
