## Flash Theology: God is Wise

Why should I trust God? (Job 38:1-11 NLT)

1. God is <u>eternally wise</u>. (Job 38:2 NLT; Romans 16:27 NIV; Psalm 147:5 NET)

FLASH FACT: *Omnisapient* = "all wise"

a. God's *wisdom* is beautifully *complex*. (Job 38:4-5 NLT)

We live in a world that is *post-Fall* and *pre-Eschaton*. (Isaiah 55:8-9 NIV)

"If God would concede me his *omnipotence [power]* for twenty-four hours, you would see how many changes I would make in the world. *But if he gave me his wisdom* too, I would leave things as they are."

2. God's wisdom compels me to trust Him. (Job 42:1-6 NLT)

Job's resolution was *not* through an *explanation from* God but an *encounter with* God.

Let the *character of God* as seen in the cross be the *wisdom* that shapes my *perspective*.

Bottom Line: God is *worthy* of our trust *because* He is *wise*.
