The Gospel of John: Come and See "Born Again" John 3:1-21 CSB

"A man can die of starvation knowing all about bread, and a man can remain spiritually dead while knowing all the historic facts of Christianity." – A.W. Tozer

1. <u>Transformation</u> does not simply come from <u>information</u>. (John 3:1-2 CSB)

I must be *born again* in order to *begin* the transformation. (John 3:3, 5,10 CSB; Ezekiel 36:25-26 CSB)

2. <u>Receive</u> the gift of God's <u>love</u> and let Him <u>transform</u> you.

You don't transform you...God does. (John 3:16 CSB)

To believe = to change your allegiance

Transformation is *not about knowing* Jesus loves you; it's about *being changed* by Jesus' love for you.

Romans 5:8 CSB But God proves his own love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

John 3:16 CSB For God loved	in this way: He gave his one
and only Son, so that	will believe in him and will not perish
but have eternal life.
