## The Gospel of John: Come and See "Do You Want To Be Better" John 5:1-23 CSB

Jesus has a <u>vision</u> for your life.

- Those with vision look at the future with *optimism* and *opportunity*.
- Those with vision know their *value* and their *values*.
- Those with vision are driven by a core set of *cohesive priorities*.
- 1. Jesus offers hope when we feel stuck. (John 5:6 CSB)
  - a. Jesus *listens* to the *reasons* we feel hopeless. (John 5:7 CSB)

"What if?" if applied to the past, creates regret.

"What if?" if applied to the future, fosters faith!

2. Jesus speaks a better word. (John 5:8-9 CSB)

What better word are we speaking over our community?

Embracing *Christ's vision* for our lives creates a *ripple effect*.
