

**The Gospel of John: Come and See  
“Now I See”**

**John 9:1-12, 30-41 (CSB)**

How does God want to make use of the pains in my life for my gain and His glory?

- 1. Know that God sees me even before I can see Him or what He’s doing.** (John 9:1, 3b, 5 CSB)

What if a part of my story that I *resent* is something God wants to *redeem*?  
What if He wants to *reveal* Himself to others through it?

- 2. Let God turn my trial into my testimony.** (John 9:30, 38, 41 CSB)

1 Peter 1:5–7 (CSB) ***You are being guarded by God’s power*** through faith for a salvation that is ready to be revealed in the last time. You rejoice in this, even though now for a short time, if necessary, ***you suffer grief in various trials so that the proven character of your faith***—more valuable than gold which, though perishable, is refined by fire—***may result in praise, glory, and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ.***
