

**The Gospel of John: Come and See
“The Good Shepherd”
John 10:1-30 (CSB)**

1. Know the voice of the Good Shepherd. (John 10:3-4 CSB)

How do I listen for the voice of Jesus?

- Find space for **silence**.
- Get **Scripture** in you!
- Spend less time on **technology** and more time **outside**.
- Make “listening” for God’s voice a **posture**, not a **to-do**.

a. **Follow** the **voice** of the Good Shepherd. (John 10:4-5 CSB)

2. Rest in the care of the Good Shepherd. (Psalm 23 NLT;
John 10:10-11 CSB)

Greek: αγαθος (*agathos*) = “good” as in moral or virtuous

Greek: καλος (*kalos*) = “good” as in beautiful and compelling

John 10:14 (CSB) “***I am the good [kalos] shepherd***. I know my own, and my own know me.”

Jesus, our Good Shepherd...

- **guards** and **guides** us
- is **tender** toward His sheep but **fierce** toward adversaries
- will not **shelter us** from “dark valleys,” but He will **shepherd us** through them
- gives us **eternal life** (John 10:27-28 CSB)

“**Never**” from the Greek **οὐ μὴ** (pronounced: *ou-may*) is a double negative; emphatically saying “never ever!”
