## Compass: Finding True North – Truth Over Relativism

John 8:31-32 To the Jews who had believed him, Jesus said, "If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."

How does embracing God's truth set me free?

**1. Biblical truth unleashes a <u>fruitful</u> life.** (Colossians 1:9-10; Jeremiah 17:7-8 NLT)

What kind of "fruit" is "my truth" currently producing? (Galatians 5:22-23a NLT)

- 2. Biblical truth more deeply connects me with God. (Colossians 1:10)
- **3.** Biblical truth <u>strengthens</u> <u>me</u> to hold on tight. (Colossians 1:10-11; Romans 5:3-5)
- 4. Biblical truth fuels my gratitude. (Colossians 1:10-14, 23)
