How do I know God cares about me?

1. God knows me completely. (Psalm 139:1-6 NIV)

“He is omniscient, which means that He knows in one free and effortless act all matter, all spirit, all relationships, all events.” – A.W. Tozer, *The Pursuit of God*

- God is interested in everything I **do** (my actions). (Psalm 139:1-2 NIV)
- God knows **why** I do what I do (my motives). (Psalm 139:2-3 NIV)
- God even knows what I am going to **say** before I say it (my words). (Psalm 139:4 NIV)

God’s knowledge is unlimited. Knowing that God is omniscient should allow us to trust His will, His Word, and His timing. Though we don’t know all the answers, God does.

2. God is with me everywhere I go. (Psalm 139:7-12 NIV)

- God is everywhere... (Psalm 139:7 NIV)
- ...and yet He never leaves my side. (Psalm 139:10 NIV)

3. God designed me and values me. (Psalm 139:13-18 NIV)
