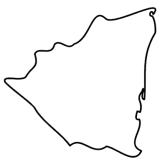
The Godwin's primary focus is church planting among the unreached of Estonia. 90% of those under the age of 40 believe there is no God.

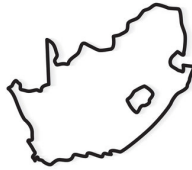


# THE SUES JAPAN
