Let's go in our Bibles to Romans 5:1-5 (CSB)

1. We <u>now</u> live at <u>peace</u> with <u>God</u> through Jesus.

Romans 5:1 (CSB) Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, **we have peace with God** through our Lord Jesus Christ.

a. The peace we have received changes our past, present, and future.

Romans 5:2 (CSB) **We have also obtained access** through him by faith **into this grace** in which **we stand**, and **we boast** in the hope of the glory of God.

2. God transforms hardships into hope.

Romans 5:3 (CSB) And not only that, but **we also boast in our afflictions**, because we know that **affliction produces endurance**...

Romans 5:4 (CSB) endurance produces **proven character** and proven character produces **hope**.

Romans 5:5 (CSB) **This hope** will not disappoint us, because **God's love has been poured out in our hearts** through the Holy Spirit who was given to us.
