2024 was a historic year for Newbreak and for me, personally. As I near the one-year mark of becoming the Lead Pastor at Newbreak, I am humbled by God's work this past year.

In 1 Corinthians 3:6, Paul acknowledges God's work in expanding the early church by writing, "I planted the seed, Apollos watered it, but God has been making it grow." In the same way, while each of us is called to plant and water seeds, we must recognize that growth happens because of God!

This year was a year of growth at Newbreak Church! We saw new people find God and community at each of our campuses. Over the previous year, Sunday attendance grew by 10%, engagement in life groups grew by 8%, and giving increased by 19%! These numbers represent lives being transformed, relationships being strengthened, and faith deepening within our church family. We celebrate all that God is doing at Newbreak and look forward to even greater impact in the year ahead!.

In the fall, we launched a two-year discipleship and generosity initiative called Prepare the Way, which will fund all that God is calling us to do over the next two years. As of the end of 2024, we are already 10% of the way towards our total \$12.8 million dollar funding goal. Our plan is to begin construction this fall in Scripps Ranch!

Last year, we felt the call to serve the different language groups here in San Diego. In April of 2024, we launched our first-ever Brazilian life group to serve the Portuguese-speaking community in our city.

God has done great things already as we have seen up to 35 people join this group every week. We can't wait to see how God continues to use Newbreak to serve every nation, tribe, and tongue here in San Diego!





Check out what God is doing in Papua New Guinea through one of our ministry partners, Adam Boyd, as his team translates the Bible into the Enga language.

On July 11, I received a message saying, "This is what it feels like to hold a miracle in your hands!" The message had a picture of someone holding the Enga New Testament Bible.

The miracle began when we made the decision to join Wycliffe Bible Translators. We settled in the village of Imi among the Dyuapini tribe, notorious for their history of tribal fighting. Other Engans were afraid to go to Imi, and many Engans advised us not to live among the Dyuapini, but as long as we have lived in Imi, the Dyuapini people have lived in peace, even

while so much of Enga is at war.

The Enga translators themselves have faced enormous challenges. Frank's village was attacked, and many of the houses were burned to the ground as Frank and his family fled to the hills. William has been confined to his home for many months because hired hitmen from the enemy tribe are roaming around Wabag town. Martin lost most of his eyesight three years ago but still faithfully



plugs away at the translation work each day with the help of his daughter. Reuben's home was burned to the ground by an enemy tribe, while Maniosa dealt with persecution from church leaders for seeking needed reforms in his denomination. But in God's grace, each of them has persevered.

The miracle of the Enga New Testament is now in the hands of thousands of Enga people

despite the best efforts of the enemy to stop us every step of the way. We can now attest through experience that "Greater is he who is in us than he who is in the world."
